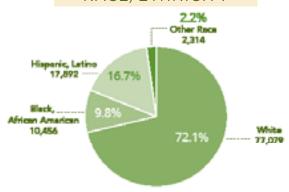
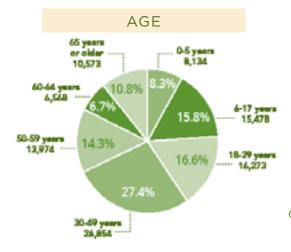

HOUSEHOLD DEMOGRAPHICS

- 73% live at or below poverty level.
- 60% live on less than \$10,000 a year.
- 56% have a member with a paying job in the past 12 months.
- 10% have a full- or part-time student.
- 20% have a member who served in the armed forces.
- 56% participate in SNAP.
- 11% have a grandparent as primary caregiver of grandchildren.

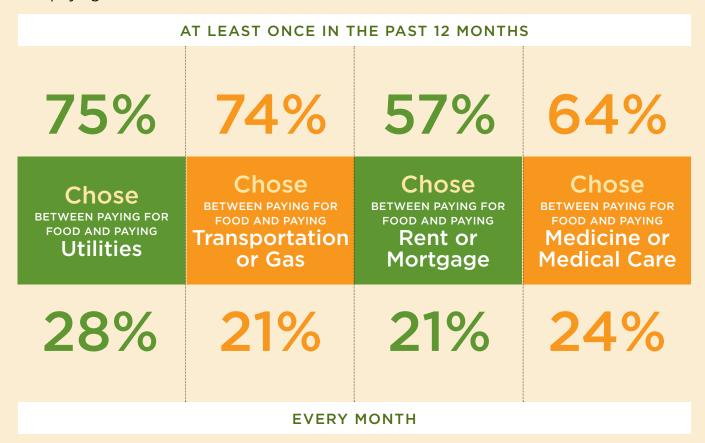
FOOD CHOICES: COST & AVAILABILITY

- Nearly 9 out of 10 households report buying the cheapest food available regardless of health as a strategy for getting enough to eat.
- When asked what products they desire that are not currently available at program, the top 3 responses are:

61% FRUIT & VEGETABLES

52% MEAT & PROTEIN 42%

SPENDING TRADE-OFFS: Client households made trade-offs between paying for food and paying for other necessities.



COPING STRATEGIES: With 73% of households living at or below poverty level, clients must employ trade-off strategies in order to put food on the table.
